The BT Revelation is a flexible and feature-rich analogue telephone system designed specifically for the small business.

It can operate as a PBX with all calls being answered by an operator, or you can use it as a key system with all calls being answered by all extensions, or a combination of the two.

The BT Revelation is a hybrid system and you connect any combination of Systemphones or standard analogue telephones.

The Systemphone

The Systemphone makes it very easy to use and manage the BT Revelation. It has a 16-character LCD display and prompt keys to guide you through the facilities.

It is fully handsfree so you can make and receive calls and use features, without lifting the handset. It also has 16 programmable keys for quick access to features or for monitoring the status of lines and extensions.

The Systemphone support Caller Display Service on the Mark-II system.

System Options

The BT Revelation comes in four different sizes: one line + six extensions, 2 lines + six extensions, 3 lines + nine extensions or 4 lines and 12 extensions.

Whichever system you begin with, you can easily expand to the maximum capacity.

There are two different system versions, the basic Mark-I system or the more advanced Mark-II, which includes Courtesy Service and Caller Display.

- **DISA**
(Direct Inward System Access) is built-in as standard, callers can ring straight in to an extension if they know the number.
- **Voice Module**
The optional voice module answers incoming callers and gives a pre-recorded or personalised greeting prompting callers to dial the department or person they require. It also acts as a central answering machine when calls are unanswered with a 10-minute storage capacity.

SYSTEM FEATURES

Alarm call

Set your phone to ring at the required time

Advisory messages

Display messages for systemphones calling your extension. Preset and personalised.

Call barring

Restrictions placed on an extension to control the types of number that can be called. The barring imposed is set by the Class of service programmed.

Call diversion

Calls can be diverted to another extension permanently or when your extension is busy or does not answer.

Call pickup

External calls or any call ringing at another extension can be answered at your own extension.

Call waiting tone

You can be given an optional tone to alert you when other callers are waiting.

Caller display memory

Information about the last 50 calls to the system is stored automatically. Number, date and time of call are stored and a message is displayed at the operator's extension when there are new unanswered calls.

Caller display routing

Up to 30 names can be associated with numbers for quick recognition of incoming callers, these numbers can also be programmed to automatically route to one extension if required.

Class of service

Each extension may be programmed for a class of service, which determines the types of calls the extension is allowed to dial. There are 5 classes available with customisable options.

Conference

You can initiate a 3-way conference between 3 extensions or 2 extensions and an external number.

Courtesy service

Provides a courtesy greeting to incoming callers queuing or on hold.

Extension lock

Your extension can be locked with a PIN code to prevent unauthorised users from making external calls.

Line assignment

This feature allows you to decide which exchange lines each extension has access to for outgoing calls.

Manager/secretary working

A feature used to maximise the way 2 people work together.

MOH (Music on Hold)

The system plays music to caller who have been put on hold.

Night service

Allows you to programme a different set of call restriction and ringing assignments for day and night working. Switchover can be automatic at pre-programmed times or manual.

Paging

Make announcements through the system to an external PA system or through the loudspeakers of all systemphones.

Ringing assignments

You can decide which extensions ring for each exchange line connected to the system. Additionally 20-sec ringing cycles of extension can be set to hunt for an answer.

Room monitor

Also known as baby monitor, dial into a handset to listen in from a monitoring extension.

Speed dialling

Speed dialling enables you to dial frequently-used numbers using two or three digit codes.

System management

The BT Revelation system can be managed quickly and easily from a systemphone connected to the programming position with PIN code access.
